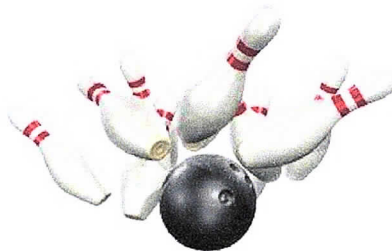

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION:

- THREE GAME SERIES** will be bowled in each or any division by each entrant. Highest series to win in each case.
- ELIGIBILITY** is open to all Tasmanian TBA Registered Bowlers who compete in a TBA Registered Centre. To be eligible to compete in the Adult championships, bowlers must be 18 years of age as at 19th September 2020. To be eligible to compete in the Junior championships, bowlers must not have had their 18th birthday by the 1st January 2020.
- ENTRIES** should be submitted to the Tournament Director (postal address- PO Box 1188, Launceston Tas 7250) by 4th September 2020 for juniors & 11th September 2020 for adults. Entries will be accepted on the day, subject to lane availability.
- CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES.** Players are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 18 games as at 14th August 2020.
NOTE. ALL BOWLERS MUST PRODUCE PROOF OF AVERAGES TO RECEIVE ANY PRIZES / MONEY.
- PRIZE MONEY.** Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned 100% on the basis of 1 in 4 entries.
- BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE** must apply to the Tournament Director for classification.
- REPLACEMENTS** or changes to the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Director at least 45 mins prior to the event starting. No refund will be given after this time elapses.
- ALL EVENTS.** An All Events Champion will be declared for every grade contested. The bowler's average will determine their all events classification. Scores for each bowler's best appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total.
- MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION.** A team may bowl in their own grade and once in a higher grade. Open teams may bowl twice in their own grade. Any two bowlers from that team may form a new team and bowl again. **DOUBLES** Bowlers may have unlimited entries, but may only bowl twice with the same partner.
- SPECIAL NOTE:** Any matters not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee. ALL T.B.A . RULES APPLY.
- This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Coronavirus Stage 3 Restrictions and enforce the following social distancing requirements :- athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person, no contact with high fives and handshakes prohibited during the event & athletes should maintain good hygiene and cleaning practises.

DRESS CODE:

All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Men may wear long pants or neat shorts (shorts not permitted in the masters final). Ladies may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, ¾ pants or skorts.

NO jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, t-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.

Qualifying series will be the highest three (3) games singles or doubles attempt bowled during the championships until completion of the 9.00am squad on Sunday 20th September.

Finals – Sunday 20th September 2020. Check in 10.15am. Cost of Final - \$60.00

Top 7 male & female qualifiers plus defending champions. The final will be over 8 games scratch pinfall. The bowler with the highest pinfall will be declared the Masters Champion for 2020 and receive automatic entry into the 2021 State Masters and the 2021 Launceston Masters (Costs for both finals to be met by the bowler). Prize payout will be one in every four qualifiers.

ADULT RESTRICTED MASTERS

This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 for bowlers whose averages are 184 & Under for men & 174 & Under for women. Qualifying series will be the highest three (3) games singles or doubles plus handicap attempt bowled during the championships until completion of the 9.00am squad on Sunday 20th September.

Finals – Sunday 20th September 2020 Check in 10.15 am. Cost of Final - \$50.00

Top 6 male & female qualifiers including defending champions (if still eligible). The final will be over 6 games and the bowler with the highest pinfall + handicap will be declared the Restricted Masters Champions for 2020 and receive automatic entry into the 2021 State Restricted Masters and the 2021 Launceston Restricted Masters (Costs for both finals to be met by the bowler). Prize payout will be one in every four qualifiers.

JUNIOR MASTERS

Qualifying series will be the highest three (3) games singles or doubles attempt bowled during the championships until completion of the 10.30am squad on Saturday 12th September.

Finals – Saturday 12th September 2020 Check in 11.45 am. Cost of Final - \$50.00

Top 7 boy & girl qualifiers plus defending champions. The final will be over 8 games scratch pinfall. The bowler with the highest pinfall will be declared the Masters Champion for 2020 and receive automatic entry into the 2021 State Masters and the 2021 Launceston Masters (Costs for both finals to be met by the bowler). Prize payout will be one in every four qualifiers.

JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS

This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 for bowlers whose averages are 169 & Under for boys & 159 & Under for girls. Qualifying series will be the highest three (3) games singles or doubles plus handicap attempt bowled during the championships until completion of the 10.30am squad on Saturday 12th September.

Finals – Saturday 12th September 2020 Check in 11.45 am. Cost of Final - \$40.00

Top 6 boy & girl qualifiers including defending champions (if still eligible). The final will be over 6 games and the bowler with the highest pinfall + handicap will be declared the Restricted Masters Champion for 2020 and receive automatic entry into the 2021 State Restricted Masters and the 2021 Launceston Restricted Masters (Costs for both finals to be met by the bowler). Prize payout will be one in every four qualifiers.

Ties – In the event of any ties for the final qualifying or first place, a single game will be played to break the tie. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken. All other ties will be broken by highest last game.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

2020 LTBA Adult & Junior Championships COVID guidelines and protocols – August 2020

The following guidelines are adopted by Launceston Tenpin Bowling Association Inc. in relation to playing in the 2020 LTBA Adult & Junior Championships. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2020.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
