Rules and General Information

- THREE GAME SERIES:** In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in the teams, doubles and singles events; the highest scratch three game series to win in each event.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all 2020 registered players of Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd and who are in good standing and who have attained the age of 18 years on or prior to the first day of the championships. All bowlers will be required to present their 2020 TBA Registered Player Card, or receipt of payment, at check-in.
- CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:** Averages must have been established in a TBA league or accredited tournament, playing to a regular schedule, prior to midnight, 31st December 2019.
- WHICH AVERAGE TO USE:** Players are to use their highest current league or tournament average gained over a minimum of eighteen (18) games.
- BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE:** A bowler who has no average over eighteen (18) games in accordance with Rules 4. and 5. must apply to the Tournament Director for average classification prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made then the entering average will be the minimum required for Open Grade. The Tournament Director has the right to re-grade any bowler or entry.
- PRIZE FUND:** All prize money contributed by the bowlers will be returned 100% on the basis of one prize for each 4 entries.
- REPLACEMENTS/CHANGES:** All replacements and changes to the original entry must be submitted to the Tournament Committee at least **15 minutes** before the time scheduled to bowl.
- ALL-EVENTS:** Mixed teams/mixed doubles scores do count towards all-events scores. A bowlers highest series in teams (or mixed teams), doubles (or mixed doubles) and singles will become their all events score in the grade of their entering average.
- MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** A bowler may have unlimited singles, doubles and teams entries. They may bowl with the same team and doubles partners.
- DRESS CODE:** All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Men may wear long pants or neat shorts (shorts not permitted in the Masters final). Ladies may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, ¾ pants or skorts. **NO** jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, t-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.
- SPECIAL NOTE:** The Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final, will decide any matters that may arise and which are not covered by these rules.
- ENTRIES:** Entries should be sent to the Tournament Director, Tenpin Bowling Tasmania, PO Box 1188, Launceston 7250 or emailed to tenpintas@tenpin.org.au by Friday 7th August 2020. Entries will be accepted on the day, subject to lane availability.
- This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Coronavirus Stage 3 Restrictions and enforce the following social distancing requirements :- athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person, no contact with high fives and handshakes prohibited during the event & athletes should maintain good hygiene and cleaning practises.

Masters – Open, Seniors & Restricted

State Open Masters

Qualifying: -

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (5.30pm) Saturday 22nd August 2020. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 10th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

2019 State Masters Champions (male and female), plus current area champions and qualifiers (to a maximum of 10 bowlers) will go into the final. Finals will be 9 games matchplay plus a positional round (30 bonus pins for a win, 15 for a draw). Winners to be decided on total pinfall plus bonuses. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 23rd August 2020 with check in at 9am.

Cost of final: \$70.00.

Seniors Cup

Qualifying: -

***A Senior is defined as a bowler who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition.*

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (5.30pm) on the 15th August 2020. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 6th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

2019 Seniors Cup Champions (male and female) plus Qualifiers to make up a maximum of 6 finalists men and women. Finals will be over 6 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 16th August 2020 with check in at 9am.

Cost of final: \$50.00.

Restricted Cup

Qualifying: -

***Restricted to bowlers with entering averages NOT exceeding 184 for men's division and 174 for women's division.*

Please note: Bowlers must provide proof of average for Restricted Cup by showing a copy of the standing sheet for each league they bowl in as at the 31st December 2019. Handicap event based on 100% of 200.

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (5.30pm) on the 15th August 2020. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 10th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall + handicap to break the tie.

Finals: -

2019 Restricted Cup Champions (male and female) plus current area Restricted Champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers will go into the finals (maximum 10 finalists). Finals will be handicapped (100% of 200) and will be over 10 games with the highest pinfall + handicap to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 16th August 2020 with check in at 11.30am.

Cost of final: \$70.00.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships COVID guidelines and protocols – August 2020

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2020.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of 2 square metres per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
