RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **THREE GAME SERIES** In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in the teams, doubles and singles events; the highest scratch three game series to win in each event.
2. **ELIGIBILITY** is open to all Tasmanian Junior TBA Registered bowlers (must NOT have had their 18th birthday by 1st January 2020) who compete in a TBA registered centre.
3. **ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BY 14th August 2020.** Late entries will be accepted by the Tournament Director subject to lane availability.
4. **CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:** Players are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 18 games as at **31st December 2019**.
5. **WHICH AVERAGE TO USE:** Players are to use their highest current league or tournament average gained over a minimum of eighteen (18) games
6. **BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE:** A bowler who has no average over eighteen (18) games in accordance with Rules 4 and 5 must apply to the Tournament Director for average classification prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made then the entering average will be the minimum required for Open Grade. The Tournament Director has the right to re-grade any bowler or entry.
7. **PRIZE MONEY.** Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned 100% on the basis of 1 in 4 entries.
8. **REPLACEMENTS** or changes to the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Director at least 15 minutes prior to the event starting. No refund will be given after this time elapses.
9. **ALL EVENTS.** Mixed teams and mixed doubles scores do count towards all-events scores. A bowlers highest series in teams (or mixed teams), doubles (or mixed doubles) and singles will become their all events score in the grade of their entering average
10. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION.** A bowler may have unlimited singles, doubles and teams entries. They may bowl with the same team and doubles partners.
11. **SPECIAL NOTE:** The Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final, will decide any matters that may arise and which are not covered by these rules.
12. **This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Coronavirus Stage 3 Restrictions and enforce the following social distancing requirements :- athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person, no contact with high fives and handshakes prohibited during the event & athletes should maintain good hygiene and cleaning practises.**

ALL T.B.A . RULES APPLY.

DRESS CODE:

All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Boys may wear long pants or neat shorts (shorts not permitted in the masters final). Girls may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, ¾ pants or skorts.

NO jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, t-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.

OPEN MASTERS FINAL

Qualifying: to be completed up until the last available squad (5.30pm) on 22nd August, 2020. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$5.00 fee.

2019 State Junior Masters Champions plus current area champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers (to a maximum of 8 bowlers) will participate in the final. Final will be over 8 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Prize fund payout will be one in every eight qualifiers.

In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

RESTRICTED MASTERS

This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 for bowlers whose averages are 169 & under for boys and 159 & under for girls. Please note: Bowlers must provide proof of average for Restricted Masters by showing a copy of the standing sheet for each league they bowl in as at the 31st December 2019.

Qualifying: to be completed up until the last available squad (5.30pm) on 22nd August, 2020. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt plus handicap bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$5.00 fee.

Final: 2019 State Junior Restricted Masters Champions plus current area champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers (to a maximum of 6 bowlers) will participate in the final. Final will be over 8 games with the highest pinfall plus handicap to decide the winners. Prize fund payout will be one in every four qualifiers. In the event of a tie for the 6th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest scratch pinfall plus handicap to break the tie.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships COVID guidelines and protocols – August 2020

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2020.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
