Any junior who did not satisfy that age requirement but will have their 18th birthday before the Rachuig event can renounce their Junior status and pay an Adult membership fee if they wish to bowl in the competition.
2. This tournament is a scratch event and all TBA rules and regulations will apply.
3. To be eligible to bowl in the Rachuig tournament, participants must have upgraded to Silver sports registration and bowled a minimum of 24 games in a Registered Centre in a League in Tasmania during the 12 months prior to the tournament. League games completed as pre bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
4. Bowlers must be a financial member of a TBA – in good standing. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
5. Entry in to multiple state team roll offs is permitted. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per person for the 1st event entered and then \$30 for each subsequent event (For example, if a bowler is eligible and wishes to compete in 2 roll offs, the total entry fee would be \$160). Entry fees may be refundable under certain circumstances at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

All bowlers must return Entry Form, Declaration & TBT Code of Conduct Agreement and payment of Entry Fee no later than Friday 29th January 2021.

If all of the top six bowlers are over 25, the bowler finishing sixth will not be in the team. Instead the highest placed bowler aged under 25 will fill the team. In the event of a tie for sixth place, there will be a one game play off to decide the position.
8. Bowlers are to adhere to the TBA Code of Ethics, a copy of which is available on the TBA website. Warning cards: Yellow and red cards to be shown at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Red card will mean disqualification from the tournament.

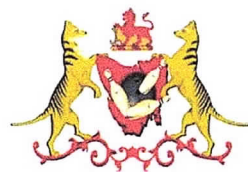

No jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director. Any bad conduct or language will not be tolerated during the tournament. Warning cards, Yellow and Red, to be shown at the discretion of the Tournament Director. A Red Card will mean disqualification from the tournament.

ELIGIBILITY:

The ATBSO Tas. (Inc.) Challenge Team Trials are open to all 2021 registered TBA Ltd bowlers, who are financial members of the ATBSO Tasmania (Inc.), regardless of average, who have competed in at least 3 ATBSO Tas. events in the 12 months prior to this Elimination and who have a current league average over a minimum of 18 games at 31/12/2020. Nominees must also compete in this Eliminations, the 2021 ATBSO Tas. Championships and two other ATBSO Tas events before the commencement of Seniors Week to be eligible to represent ATBSO Tasmania in Campbelltown.

Bowlers must also be 45 years of age before the 20th August 2021 to be eligible to compete in these Team Eliminations.

In accordance with Article 6.6.(b) of the ATBSO Tasmania Constitution – Team members, including Managers, are responsible for all the cost associated with representing the ATBSO Tasmania. These costs include, but are not limited to, transport, accommodation, lineage, entry fees and uniforms.

OPEN, CLASSIC & RESTRICTED CHALLENGE ELIMINATIONS

The Restricted & Classic Challenge's will be bowled over the same format as the Open Event and with the same number of games and entry charges. When filling in your entry form you must nominate your grade. Eg. **Open, Classic or Restricted.** Restricted players will bowl with same rules, except their handicap will be added. Restricted & Classic Event Averages for the Eliminations, will be your current ATBSO Tas. Tournament average over a minimum of 18 games, or if ATBSO Tas. Tournament Average not available over the 18 games, then their highest league average will be used (Also over a minimum of 18 Games.). This average is as at **December 31st 2020**. That is, 179 max. men & 169 max. women for in the Restricted Teams. Classic will be bowled as a **SCRATCH** event with averages a maximum of 189 for Women & 199 for Men. Proof of average will be required. When competing in August bowlers averages will revert to their ATBSO Tournament average over a minimum of 18 games, as at **1st June 2021**. Proof of average at 1st June 2021, will be supplied by the State Tournament Director. A bowler may bowl in any TWO teams. that is either Open/ Classic, Restricted / Classic or Open / Restricted, they must not stop another bowler competing by bowling in two teams. The extra team will be at the bowlers own cost of lineage. **See National Constitution 6.2 Rule 3.**

If a team loses a player before competing in Campbelltown, for any reason, then a Tasmanian replacement can be bought in as long as he / she has bowled in the Tasmanian Championships and the Tasmanian State Team Eliminations, other wise a DRAFT player will be called for Nationally. This rule is as per National Constitution. A maximum of 3 Draft players can be used per team. (See National Rules & Regulations.)

ENTRY FEES: The total cost of the ATBSO Elimination Team Trials is **\$130.00** and can be bowled in conjunction with any other ATBSO/TBT Team Trial at an additional cost of **\$30**. Entry Fees are payable by **Friday 29th January, 2021 AT 7:00pm** and must be lodged with the nomination form.

REFUNDS: If required any unbowled games will be refunded.



FORMAT & TEAMS: At the conclusion of 16 games (8 games per day), the top six (6) men and six (6) women from the scratch trials will be the 2021 ATBSO Tas. State Open TEAMS to compete in the "NATIONAL ATBSO TEAMS CHALLENGE" Tournament in **Campbelltown City Bowl NSW, from Friday 20th August 2021**. Similarly, the top six (6) men and six (6) women handicap scores from the Restricted trials will be the 2021 ATBSO Tas State Restricted TEAM to compete in the "NATIONAL RESTRICTED ATBSO TEAMS CHALLENGE". The Classic team will consist of 3 Men & 3 Women and the final positions for the Classic Teams, will be decided by total scratch pinfall, bowled over the total number of games required in the Eliminations format. The handicap for the Restricted section will be based on 90% of 200. The Open and Classic is a scratch events with no handicap. In the event of a tie for any final team position, a one (1) game play-off will decide the final position.

DISPUTES: All TBA rules and regulations will apply. Any dispute or complaint must be lodged in writing with the Tournament Director within 48 hours of the alleged infringement. Disputes will be decided by the Tournament Director and if required by the Executive committee whose decision will be final.

SMOKING: There will be no smoking once bowling start until the completion of each day.

Additional INFORMATION for participants:

PARTICIPATION IN THE TEAM TRIALS IS A COMMITMENT TO TEAM REPRESENTATION AT THE NATIONALS, in CAMPBELLTOWN NEW SOUTH WALES.

- TBT Code of conduct is administered by the TBT Tournament Director
- **All Team members will be required to attend ALL scheduled official practice sessions, unless a valid reason is given to the Team Manager. Notification of these sessions will be given to the bowlers at least 2 weeks in advance.**
- In the period leading up to the ATBSO Challenge in Campbelltown, NSW, all team members ***WILL be INVITED*** to participate in fund raising activities to offset costs. ALL EXPENSES requiring payment must be paid in full no later than 5 weeks prior to the departure date, or that person will be replaced by the next available bowler from the trials.
- The expected cost for 2021 will be approximately \$2,000.00 per bowler. Of this amount, \$200 must be paid by Thursday **22nd April 2021** either to the Treasurer or into an account nominated by the ATBSO Tas.
- Final payment will be required by Friday **16th July 2021**
- **Those not participating in fundraising activities will be required to pay the complete costs of all expenses.**
- All Team members, before bowling in the National Teams Challenge in Campbelltown New South Wales, must bowl a National "All Events" Entry. This is a National Body requirement. The ATBSO Tas. Board of Directors will arrange these entries on behalf of the team members and in consultation with any Team Managers that it has appointed. Bowlers may also request additional entries to be organised by the Board of Directors.
- The breach of any rules may result in a team member being replaced by the next available bowler from the trials.
- All playing rules for these Eliminations shall be determined by the TBT Tournament Director.
- **Bowling as a Substitute for another State:** To bowl as a substitute for another state, a Bowler must be nominated by His / Her State Committee and must be the next available from team trials.
- **All participants are required to read and complete the Declaration and TBT Code of conduct Agreement attached to this form.**

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

2021 Tasmanian State Team Selection Trials COVID guidelines and protocols – February 2021

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the 2021 Tasmanian State Team Selection Trials. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2021.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.

Team members must understand that their commitment is to the Tasmanian Teams and the performance of the team as a whole. Social or leisure activities on an individual basis should NOT be organized without the prior approval of the Team Manager.

Team members must be well presented at all times. Personal or commercial advertisement, or any motivational or visual display and/or signage or sponsorship will not be displayed on Tasmanian Team uniforms and/or Tasmanian Practice shirts without the prior approval of the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. – Adult Tournament & Junior Sub-Committees.

Bowlers must follow the directives given by the Team managers and Coaches at all times. The aims and objectives of the team as a whole will not be jeopardized through the acts of individual team members.

Team members and/or his/her family shall not at any time post on any public forum any comments which in the absolute discretion of the TBT Board may be regarded as critical of TBT, TBT Committees, Team Management, Team Coaches, Team Members or other bowlers in general.

Failure by any team member to adhere to the Declaration and TBT Code of Conduct Agreement may result in them being replaced in the team by the next available reserve or removal and departure from the team at their own expenses.
