RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. **THREE GAME SERIES** will be bowled in each or any division by each entrant. Highest series to win in each case.
2. **ELIGIBILITY** is open to all 2021 TBA Registered Bowlers who compete in a TBA Registered Centre. To be eligible to compete in the Adult championships, bowlers must be 18 years of age as at 1st January 2021. To be eligible to compete in the Junior championships, bowlers must not have had their 18th birthday by the 1st January 2021.
3. **ENTRIES** should be submitted to the Tournament Director (postal address- PO Box 1188, Launceston Tas 7250) by 12th March 2021. Entries will be accepted on the day, subject to lane availability.
4. **CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES.** Players are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 18 games as at 31st December 2020.
NOTE. ALL BOWLERS MUST PRODUCE PROOF OF AVERAGES TO RECEIVE ANY PRIZES / MONEY.
5. **PRIZE MONEY.** Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned 100% on the basis of 1 in 4 entries.
6. **BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE** must apply to the Tournament Director for classification.
7. **REPLACEMENTS** or changes to the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Director at least 15 mins prior to the event starting. No refund will be given after this time elapses.
8. **ALL EVENTS.** An All Events Champion will be declared for every grade contested. The bowler's average will determine their all events classification. Scores for each bowler's best appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total.
9. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION.** A bowler may have unlimited singles, doubles and team entries. They may bowl with the same doubles and team members.
10. **SPECIAL NOTE:** Any matters not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee. ALL T.B.A . RULES APPLY.
11. This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Coronavirus Stage 3 Restrictions and enforce the following social distancing requirements :- athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person, no contact with high fives and handshakes prohibited during the event & athletes should maintain good hygiene and cleaning practises.

DRESS CODE:

All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Men may wear long pants or neat shorts (shorts not permitted in the masters final). Ladies may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, ¾ pants or skorts.

NO jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, t-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.

Masters – Open, Seniors, Restricted, Youth & Junior

Open Masters

Qualifying: -

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) Saturday 27th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 10th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

2020 State Masters Champions (male and female), plus current area champions and qualifiers (to a maximum of 10 bowlers) will go into the final. Finals will be 9 games matchplay plus a positional round (30 bonus pins for a win, 15 for a draw). Winners to be decided on total pinfall plus bonuses. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 28th March 2021 with check in by 9am.

Cost of final: \$70.00.

Seniors Cup

Qualifying: -

***A Senior is defined as a bowler who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition.*

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) on the 20th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

2020 Seniors Cup Champions (male and female) plus Qualifiers to make up a maximum of 8 finalists men and women. Finals will be over 8 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 21st March 2021 with check in by 9am.

Cost of final: \$60.00.

Restricted Cup

Qualifying: -

***Restricted to bowlers with entering averages NOT exceeding 184 for men's division and 174 for women's division.*

Please note: Bowlers must provide proof of average for Restricted Cup by showing a copy of the standing sheet for each league they bowl in as at the 31st December 2020. Handicap event based on 100% of 200.

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) on the 20th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall + handicap to break the tie.

Finals: -

2020 Restricted Cup Champions (male and female) plus current area Restricted Champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers will go into the finals (maximum 8 finalists). Finals will be handicapped (100% of 200) and will be over 8 games with the highest pinfall + handicap to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 21st March 2021 with check in by 9.00am.

Cost of final: \$60.00.

Junior Masters

Qualifying: -

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) Saturday 27th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

2020 State Junior Masters Champions (male and female), plus current area champions and qualifiers (to a maximum of 8 bowlers) will go into the final. Finals will be over 8 games with scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 28th March 2021 with check in by 9.00am.

Cost of final: \$60.00.

Junior Restricted Cup

Qualifying: -

***Restricted to bowlers with entering averages NOT exceeding 169 for boys and 159 for girls.*

Please note: Bowlers must provide proof of average for Restricted Cup by showing a copy of the standing sheet for each league they bowl in as at the 31st December 2020. Handicap event based on 100% of 200.

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) on the 27th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall + handicap to break the tie.

Finals: -

2020 Junior Restricted Cup Champions (male and female) plus current area Restricted Champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers will go into the finals (maximum 8 finalists). Finals will be handicapped (100% of 200) and will be over 8 games with the highest pinfall + handicap to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 28th March 2021 with check in by 9.00am.

Cost of final: \$60.00.

Youth Masters

Qualifying: -

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (4.00pm) Saturday 27th March 2021. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles, doubles or teams attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. In the event of a tie for the 8th qualifying spot or 1st place in the final, a single game will be played with the highest pinfall to break the tie.

Finals: -

Qualifiers (Male & Female to a maximum of 8 bowlers) will go into the final. Finals will be over 8 games with scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 28th March 2021 with check in by 9.00am.

Cost of final: \$60.00.

NOTE –

- **The Restricted Cup and Seniors Cup will be held together – Sunday 21st March 2021.**
- **The Junior Masters, Junior Restricted Masters and Youth Masters will be held together on Sunday 28th March 2021.**

****Restricted Cup & Senior Cup Bowlers who have qualified and wish to bowl in two finals will be required to pay \$72.**

****Junior Masters, Junior Restricted Masters & Youth Masters Bowlers who have qualified and wish to bowl in three finals will be required to pay \$84.**

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships COVID guidelines and protocols – March 2021

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the Tasmanian State Adult & Junior Championships. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2020.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
