Rules and Regulations

1. This event is open to all state teams that represented Tasmania at their most recent national event.
2. The tournament is based on 12 teams, however will be modified subject to the number of entries received. If there is an odd number of teams entered, the Tournament Director will attempt to find a makeup team.
3. Teams will bowl a 12 team league draw over one full round with each team playing each other once. All teams will consist of a minimum of 4 players with a maximum of 6 players. All participants must be TBA registered members.
4. Bowling will commence at 10am on both Saturday & Sunday. Team managers/coordinators are to check in with all entry fees paid **in CASH** at 9.30am Saturday. Lane draw for the tournament will be pre done on a first in basis on entries received by the Tournament Director with the lane draw provided at the manager/coordinator's meeting. The points system will be based on scratch score plus handicap with 1 point for an individual win and 2 points for overall team win.
5. All bowlers must bowl a **minimum of 5 games** or the team will be disqualified.
6. The tournament will be bowled with handicap and will be based on 90% of 225. Bowlers must use their highest league average as at 30th April 2021, over a minimum of 21 games. Proof of averages are to be submitted to the Tournament Director with the Entry Form. **Closing date for entries is 14th May 2021.**
7. Each team must nominate a team manager/coordinator with team entry. Team manager/coordinator will be responsible for:
 - Gathering and submitting all League standing sheets for each player.
 - Team Line-ups and team scores.
 - Bowlers bowling minimum amount of games.
 - Signing of scoresheets and forwarding to tournament director.
 - Team behaviour and conduct.
8. Only team manager/coordinators, team coaches, team players and tournament officials will be permitted in the player's area. Team line-ups must be entered left lane first.
9. At the discretion of the Tournament Director, a vacancy score may be used if a team cannot field a legal line up at any stage. Vacancy score will be 160 with 58 handicap.
10. Dress Code: shirts with a collar and dress trousers for men and shirts with a collar, skirts, trousers or tailored shorts for women. All team members including Managers to wear same uniform. Eg State shirts.
NO TRACKSUITS, NO CAPS, NO JEANS OR SHIRTS WITHOUT COLLARS.
11. Team Conduct - all teams will be expected to conduct themselves in a manner as if they were participating in their respective National Tournament.
12. **ALL TBA RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL APPLY.** Swearing and abuse of equipment will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Any intoxicated people, (alcohol or any other means) at any stage will not be permitted to take further part.
13. Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the tournament director whose decision is final.

14. Cost will be \$380.00 per team.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

2021 State Teams Challenge -

COVID guidelines and protocols – May 2021

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the 2021 State Teams Challenge. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2021.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
