RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. A THREE GAME SERIES will be bowled by each competitor (in various grades) in teams, doubles and singles with separate divisions for boys and girls. (With the exception of Mixed Doubles and Mixed Teams) The highest three game total in each event will be the winner.
2. ELIGIBILITY. This tournament is open to all Tasmanian Junior TBA Registered Bowlers who participate in a TBA registered centre and who have not had their 18th birthday by January 1st 2021.
3. ALL TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.
4. Entries open from the 1st of October and will be taken on the day subject to lane availability. No refunds after entries close.
5. PRIZE MONEY. Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned 100% on the basis of 1 in 4 entries.
6. CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES : SEPTEMBER 30th 2021.
7. WHICH AVERAGE TO USE. Bowlers are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 18 games as at September 30th 2021. Proof of average must be supplied.
8. BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE. Must apply to the Tournament Director for a classification.
9. REPLACEMENTS. Or any changes to the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Director prior to the scheduled check in time.
10. ALL EVENTS. An All Events Champion will be declared for each average classification - both boys and girls.
Scores from each bowler's BEST appearance in Teams/Mixed Teams, Doubles/Mixed Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events score.
11. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION. A bowler may have unlimited singles, doubles and teams entries. They may bowl with the same team and doubles partners.
12. SPECIAL NOTE. Any matters that may arise which are not covered by these rules will be decided upon by the Tournament Committee.
13. This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Current Coronavirus Restrictions. The following social distancing requirements will be enforced.
Athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person. High fives, handshakes and team huddles are strictly prohibited during this event.

2021 JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS: SATURDAY OCTOBER 16th.

CHECK IN BY 1.15pm COST OF FINAL \$50

This is a Handicap Event based on 100% of 180 for bowlers whose averages are 169 & under for boys and 159 & under for girls.

Qualifying series will be the highest (3) games plus handicap bowled during the Championships.

Top 5 boy and girl qualifiers plus defending champion (if still eligible) will contest the final.

The 2021 JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS will be bowled over 6 games with lane changes to be made after every two games. Prize payout will be one in four.

The boy and girl with the highest pinfall plus handicap after 6 games will be declared the D.T.B.A. 2021 JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS CHAMPION.

2021 JUNIOR MASTERS FINAL: SATURDAY OCTOBER 16th.

CHECK IN BY 1.15pm COST OF FINAL \$50

This is a Scratch Event.

Qualifying series will be the highest (3) games bowled during the Championships.

Top 5 boy and girl qualifiers plus the defending champion will contest the final.

The 2021 JUNIOR MASTERS will be bowled over 6 games with lane changes to be made after every two games. Prize payout will be one in four.

The boy and girl with the highest pinfall will be declared the D.T.B.A. 2021 MASTERS CHAMPION.

TIES - In the event of any ties for the final qualifying or first place, a single game will be played to break the tie.

Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols.

Devonport Tenpin Bowling Association Inc. COVID guidelines and protocols

The following guidelines and protocols are adopted by the Devonport Tenpin Bowling Association Inc. in relation to playing in the 2021 Devonport Junior Championships.

This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit.

As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will govern the number of people in the Centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted.
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the Tournament allowing us to hold this Tournament in 2021.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

The maximum density limit of 2 square metres per person applies for indoor sport and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people.
