



Addendum to 2022 Tasmanian State Team Roll Offs Entry Form

Due to the current COVID situation in Tasmania with the number of active cases increasing daily and more and more Tasmanians requiring to quarantine, it is Tenpin Bowling Tasmania's duty of care to ensure that all bowlers and officials are safe during the tournament.

In this regard, if any bowler who has nominated for the roll offs and subsequently finds that they are unable to compete as they are required to quarantine either because they are COVID positive or classed as a close contact, they may apply for an exemption from the roll offs (exemption form attached). Completed exemption forms should be provided to the Tournament Director (together with documentation confirming requirement to quarantine) up until commencement of play on Sunday 13th February.

The roll offs will proceed under the following conditions :-

- Should no exemption requests be received, the roll offs will proceed as detailed in the entry form (Rachuig – Top six Men & Top 6 Women, TBA50 – Top four Men & Top Four Women, ATBSO Open – Top six Men & Top six Women, ATBSO Classic – Top six Men & ATBSO Restricted – Top six Men & Top six Women).
- Should exemptions be received, the roll offs will proceed as scheduled but with **FULL SELECTION** to apply. Selection will occur at the completion of play on 13th February 2022 by the Selection Committee made up of TBT Board Members. Any athlete not gaining selection may lodge an appeal with the Selection Committee within 24 hours of the announcement of the team. The process as outlined in the TBT Selection Policy will be implemented and an Appeals Panel appointed if required.

The following COVID safe measures will be implemented during the tournament :-

- Wearing of face masks compulsory when in the centre and whilst bowling.
- Pending availability, you may be required to have a Rapid Antigen Test showing a negative result prior to entering the centre on each day. TBT will provide the RAT kits free of charge.
- If you are feeling unwell, please advise the Tournament Director immediately.
