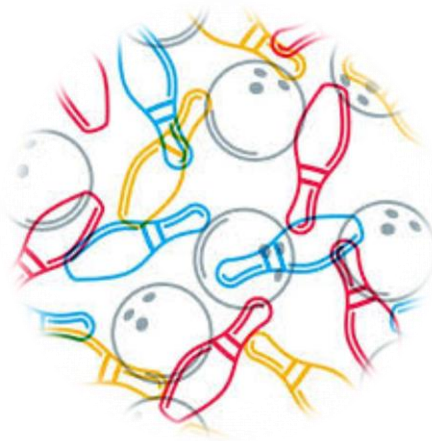

Rules and Regulations

THREE GAME SERIES: In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in the teams, doubles & singles. Highest three game series to win in each event

ELIGIBILITY: This contest is open to all Junior TBA Registered Bowlers who compete in a TBA structured league. A Junior Bowler is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 years by 1st January 2022.

Proof of age may be required on request. Bowlers must be of good standing.

ENTRIES CAN BE EMAILED TO: christinehuxley@bigpond.com or placed in HTBA box at Zone Bowling Moonah by **Sunday 8th May 2022. Entries will be accepted on the day, subject to lane availability.**

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned on the basis of one prize in every four entries. (1:4) as per TBA rules.

CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES: Players are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 15 games as at **Sunday 08th May 2022**

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE: Need to apply to the H.T.B.A. Tournament director for classification.

DRESS CODE: Bowlers will be required to dress in suitable and presentable bowling attire. The wearing of tank tops, hats, torn clothing or shirts with offensive wording or inappropriate images that may offend others will not be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: Ties - In the event of any ties for the Masters Qualifying or first place, a single game will be played to break the tie. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th Frame playoff until the tie is broken. All other ties will be broken by highest last game.

SPECIAL NOTE: Any matters not covered by these rules, will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.

It will be over **4 games** and the bowlers with the highest pinfall **plus** handicap will be declared the **HOBART JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS CHAMPION FOR 2022 WILL RECEIVE A SHIRT & AUTOMATIC ENTRY INTO QUALIFYING FOR STATE JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS 2023 & HOBART JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS 2023.**

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

HTBA Junior City Championships Sunday 15th May 2022 Tournament COVID guidelines and protocols 1

The following guidelines are adopted by the HTBA in relation to playing in the Hobart Junior City Championships. This document forms part of our modified entry form for 2022 and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by the TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will always govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player.
2. No high fives, handshakes or Team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted.
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government).
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to run the tournament in 2022.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.

ZONE BOWLING GUIDELINES

Capacity of 150 Total (Spectators Allowed)

Lane 11-14 will not be used during the tournament as these are in front of counter with limited space which do not adhere to the 2-metre rule.
