RULES AND REGULATIONS

THREE GAME SERIES: In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in teams, doubles, singles and mixed events. Highest three games series to win in each case.



ELIGIBILITY: This contest is open to all TBA Registered players with a TBA structured league average.

ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY, SUBJECT TO LANE AVAILABILITY.

CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:

Players are to use their highest accredited league average over a minimum of 21 games as **18th June 2022**.

NOTE: all bowlers must produce proof of averages to receive any prizes/money

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE: Need to apply to the **H.T.B.A. Tournament Director** for classification.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money subscribed as prize fund, will be returned on the basis of one prize in every four entries (**1:4**). City Championships and one prize in eight entries (**1:8**) Masters as per TBA rules.

TIES: In the event of any ties for the Masters qualifying or first place, a single game will be played, to break the tie. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

All other ties will be broken by highest last games.

REPLACEMENTS: All replacements or any change in the original schedule must be reported to the tournament director at least 15 minutes before the time scheduled to bowl. No refund will be given after this time elapses.

ALL EVENTS: All Events Champion will be declared in every grade contested. A bowler's average will determine their All Events classification. A bowler's highest series in teams, (or mixed teams), doubles (or mixed doubles) and singles will become their All Events score in the grade of their entering average. Only one paid All Events will be accepted from each competitor. No person will receive more than one All Events cash prize.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: A bowler may have, unlimited singles, doubles and team entries. They may bowl with the same team and doubles partners.

MIXED DOUBLES: Will count towards All Events. Unlimited number of entries

DOUBLES: Unlimited number of entries.

SINGLES: Unlimited number of entries.

TEAMS: Individual series from this event will count towards the bowlers All Events.

DRESS CODE: Bowlers will be required to dress in suitable and presentable bowling attire. The wearing of tank tops, hats, torn clothing or shirts with offensive wording or inappropriate images that may offend others will not be accepted.

COVID-19: this event is being run under TBA /Zone Bowling Return to Play guidelines.

SPECIAL NOTE:

COVID-19 STRICTLY NO CONTACT (HIGH FIVES, HANDSHAKES AND TEAM HUDDLES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED DURING THIS EVENT)

Any matters not covered by these rules, will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
ALL TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.

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Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

HTBA Hobart City Championships Tournament COVID guidelines and protocols
25th – 26th June 2022.

The following guidelines are adopted by the HTBA in relation to playing in the Hobart City Championships. This document forms part of our modified entry form for 2022 and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by the TBA and the Tasmanian Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to always be observed and will always govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player.
2. No high fives, handshakes or Team huddles are to be allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted.
3. Spectators are allowed. (As determined by the Tasmanian Government).
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to run the tournament in 2021.

COMMUNITY SPORT AND RECREATION TASMANIA

Sport, exercise and recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of midday Friday 26 June 2020.

The maximum density limit of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.

ZONE BOWLING GUIDELINES

Capacity of 150 Total (Spectators Allowed)

Lane 11-14 will not be used during the tournament as these are in front of counter with limited space which do not adhere to the 2-metre rule.
