Rules and General Information

1. **This tournament will comply with the Tasmanian Government's Coronavirus Stage 3 Restrictions and enforce the following social distancing requirements: athletes and officials should maintain 1.5 metres from other people and 2 square metres per person, no contact with high fives and handshakes prohibited during the event and athletes should maintain good hygiene and cleaning practices.** (see full disclosure on page 4)
2. **THREE GAME SERIES:** In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in the trios, doubles and singles events; the highest scratch three game series to win in each event.
3. **ELIGIBILITY:**
 - Open to all 2022 registered players of Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd who reside in Tasmania and who are in good standing. All bowlers will be required to present their 2022 TBA Registered Player Card, or receipt of payment, at check-in.
 - TBA defines a bowler with a disability as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered a disability.
 - To prove a disability, a bowler needs to provide one of the following types of evidence, if requested:
 - Valid Disability Support Pension Card (DSP), or
 - Recipient of the Child Disability Allowance, or
 - Classification Card issued by one of the following: TBAL, Deaf Sports Australia, Blind Sports Australia, Wheelchair Sports Australia or AUSRAPID (or State affiliated organisation)' or
 - Letter from a medical or educational professional; Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist, Principal of Primary, Secondary or Tertiary Education Organisation, Psychologist, General Medical Practitioner, Audiologist, Ophthalmologist, or
 - Visual evidence in the case of short statured or participants that are amputees. (An amputee at the site of a major joint, including the loss of a foot or both feet, an arm or both arms).

Note: Please note for international competition, bowlers must use the classification system used by the specific Disability Sports Organisation (e.g. AUSRAPID, Blind Sports Australia, Deaf Sports Australia and Wheelchair Sports Australia).

All TBA affiliated Associations and State Committees are required to adhere to this definition for the purposes of Disability State Championships and selection of State Teams.
4. **CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:** Averages must have been established in a TBA league or accredited tournament, playing to a regular schedule, prior to midnight, 31st July 2022.
5. **WHICH AVERAGE TO USE:** Players are to use their highest current league or tournament average gained over a minimum of eighteen (18) games. If insufficient games have been bowled in the current league season, then the yearbook average as at the 31st December 2021 is to be used.
6. **BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE:** A bowler who has no average over eighteen (18) games in accordance with Rule 4, must apply to the Tournament Director for average classification prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made, then the entering average will be the minimum required for Open Grade. The Tournament Director has the right to re-grade any bowler or entry.

7. **REPLACEMENTS/CHANGES:** All replacements and changes to the original entry must be submitted to the Tournament Committee at least **15 minutes** before the time scheduled to bowl.
8. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Men may wear long pants or neat shorts. Ladies may wear slacks, shorts, skorts, $\frac{3}{4}$ pants or skirts. **NO** jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, t-shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.
9. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** (TBA Rule 215) Unless issued an exemption by the Tournament Director, no electronic earpieces, headphones, or any other electronic device, excluding medical/hearing aids, can be worn, or used by bowlers whilst they are competing in a session of games. Requests should be accompanied by a medical certificate from a qualified medical practitioner. This also applies to Carer/Support Workers in the player's area when a squad is in play.
10. **MOBILE PHONES:** Bowlers, Carers/Support Workers **MUST** switch their mobile phones off whilst a squad is in play.
11. **NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:** For bowlers intending to attend the National Disability Championships in 2023, scores attained during this competition will be used in the selection process for the following positions:
 - Michael Cooke Memorial Shield, (highest 8 bowlers with an entering average 140 and above)
 - Cole State Challenge Cup, (highest 8 bowlers with an entering average 139 and below)
 - Open Master, (highest bowler with an average 160 and above)
 - Classic Master, (highest bowler with an average between and 120 and 159) and
 - Restricted Master, (highest bowler with an average 119 and below)
12. **CHECK IN TIMES:** Check in opens 30 minutes prior to your squad start time and closes 10 minutes prior to nominated squad starting time.
13. **TOURNAMENT RULES:** This tournament will be conducted in accordance with all TBA Rules and Regulations.
14. **ALL EVENTS:** (Optional All Events Fees \$6.00) An All Events champion, female and male, will be declared in each grade. A bowler's first appearance in singles, doubles and trios will count to the All Events score. Entering average will determine All Events classification.
15. **TIE:** In the event of a TIE, placing's will be decided from the results of the highest last game played above entering average.
16. **PRIZES:** Medals will be presented to First Place (Gold), Second Place (Silver) and Third Place (Bronze) only.
17. **SPECIAL NOTE:** The Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final, will decide any matters that may arise, and which are not covered by these rules.

Tournament COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

Tasmania Disability Championships 22nd to 23rd October 2022

The following guidelines are adopted by Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. in relation to playing in the 2022 Tasmania Disability Championships. This document forms part of our entry form and must be adhered to by all bowlers.

All guidelines and protocols are governed by Tenpin Bowling Australia and the Tasmania Government and are subject to change as these bodies see fit. As their guidelines change, the Tournament will adopt the same guidelines.

1. Social distancing rules as determined by the Tasmanian Government are to be observed and will govern the number of people in the centre at any given time and the distance between each player at all times.
2. No high fives, handshakes or team huddles are allowed at any time until restrictions are lifted.
3. Spectators are allowed. (as determined by the Tasmanian Government)
4. These restrictions are part of the terms and conditions of the tournament allowing us to restart tournaments in 2022.

Community Sport and Recreation Tasmania

Sport, Exercise and Recreation

A return to full sporting activity (indoors and outdoors) in alignment with Level C of the AIS framework comes into place as of Friday 26 June 2021.

The maximum density of [2 square metres](#) per person applies for outdoor and indoor sport, with a cap of 500 people outdoors and 250 people per single undivided space indoors (participants, athletes, support staff, officials, spectators, and volunteers are counted within the maximum).

Where practical, players and athletes should maintain 1.5 metres from other people. Larger teams should consider maintaining some small group separation at training.
