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2024 WALTER RACHUIG TEAM ROLL OFF ENTRY FORM

1. This tournament is open to all adult TBA Registered Players in Tasmania who have attained the age of 18 years as at 1st January 2024. Any junior who did not satisfy that age requirement but will have their 18th birthday before the Rachuig event can renounce their Junior status and pay an Adult membership fee if they wish to bowl in the competition.
2. This tournament is a scratch event and all TBA rules and regulations will apply.
3. To be eligible to bowl in the Rachuig tournament, participants must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a Registered Centre in a League in Tasmania during the 12 months prior to the tournament. League games completed as pre bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
4. Bowlers must be a financial member of a TBA – in good standing. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
5. Entry in to multiple state team roll offs is permitted. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per person for the 1st event entered and then \$30 for each subsequent event (For example, if a bowler is eligible and wishes to compete in 2 roll offs, the total entry fee would be \$160). Entry fees may be refundable under certain circumstances at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

All bowlers must return Entry Form, Declaration & TBT Code of Conduct Agreement and payment of Entry Fee no later than Friday 2nd February 2024.

NOTE – TBA have not confirmed the team lineup requirements at this stage, so the above (top 6) may be subject to change. Any change, will be advised prior to the start of the tournament.
8. Bowlers are to adhere to the TBA Code of Ethics, a copy of which is available on the TBA website. Warning cards: Yellow and red cards to be shown at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Red card will mean disqualification from the tournament.
9. Code of dress: All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Men may wear long pants or neat shorts. Ladies may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, ¾ pants or skorts. 2024 TBA50 TEAMS CHALLENGE ROLL OFF ENTRY FORM

1. This tournament is open to all adult TBA Registered Players in Tasmania who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of competition.
2. This tournament is a scratch event and all TBA rules and regulations will apply.
3. To be eligible to bowl in the TBA50 Teams Challenge, participants must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a Registered Centre in a League in Tasmania during the 12 months prior to the tournament. League games completed as pre bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
4. Bowlers must be a financial member of TBA – in good standing. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
5. Entry in to multiple state team roll offs is permitted. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per person for the 1st event entered and then \$30 for each subsequent event (For example, if a bowler is eligible and wishes to compete in 2 roll offs, the total entry fee would be \$160). Entry fees may be refundable under certain circumstances at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

All bowlers must return Entry Form, Declaration & TBT Code of Conduct Agreement and payment of Entry Fee no later than Friday 2nd February 2024.

2. This tournament is a scratch event and all TBA rules and regulations will apply.
3. To be eligible to bowl in the TBA21 (Youth) Teams Challenge event, participants must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a Registered Centre in a League in Tasmania during the 12 months prior to the tournament. League games completed as pre bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
4. Bowlers must be a financial member of a TBA – in good standing. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
5. Entry in to multiple state team roll offs is permitted. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per person for the 1st event entered and then \$30 for each subsequent event (For example, if a bowler is eligible and wishes to compete in 2 roll offs, the total entry fee would be \$160). Entry fees may be refundable under certain circumstances at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

2024 RESTRICTED TEAMS CHALLENGE ROLL OFF ENTRY FORM

1. This tournament is open to all adult TBA Registered Players in Tasmania who have attained the age of 18 years as at 1st January 2024.
2. To be eligible to bowl in the TBA Restricted Teams Challenge event, participants must not have any league average over a minimum of 18 games at the end of the preceding year exceeding 184 pins for the Men's Division and 174 pins for the Women's Division. **All bowlers must provide a copy of their league standing sheet with their entry form to confirm their entering average as at 31/12/2023.**
3. This tournament is a handicap event and will be calculated using 100% of the difference between the bowlers entering average and 200.
4. Each bowler must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a League in a Registered Centre during the current year. League games completed as pre bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
5. Bowlers must be a financial member of a TBA – in good standing. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
6. Entry in to multiple state team selection trials is permitted. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per person for the 1st event entered and then \$30 for each subsequent event - (for example, if a bowler is eligible and wishes to compete in 2 selection trials, the total entry fee would be \$160). Entry fees may be refundable under certain circumstances at the discretion of the Tournament Director. **All bowlers must return Entry Form, Declaration & Code of Conduct Agreement and payment of Entry Fee no later than Friday 2nd February 2024.**

If I qualify, I agree, at the discretion of the abovementioned Committee to undergo a fitness check by a person or persons nominated by the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. – Adult Tournament Sub-Committee.

I further agree to abide by all directions given by the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. – Adult Tournament Sub-Committee including practice games, dates, venues and fundraising, appropriate fitness sessions or any other requirements set out by the committee.

TBT CODE OF CONDUCT

IMPORTANT: YOU MUST READ AND UNDERSTAND:

All team members will agree to abide by the TBA Code of Ethics.

All team members **MUST** attend Compulsory Training Sessions and Tournaments prior to traveling to the national championships.

The TBA Ltd 'Drugs in Sport Policy' should be upheld at all times.

It is encouraged that team members should display an elite athlete lifestyle at all times. Behaviour must be at the highest level at all times. Swearing, Team confrontations in public, unacceptable social behaviour, childish pranks that could result in injury, and other acts, which can bring discredit to the Tasmanian Teams, will not be tolerated.

While traveling as a team, all leisure activities will be authorized by the Team Managers. Team members must understand that their commitment is to the Tasmanian Teams and the performance of the team as a whole. Social or leisure activities on an individual basis should NOT be organized without the prior approval of the Team Manager.

Team members must be well presented at all times. Personal or commercial advertisement, or any motivational or visual display and/or signage or sponsorship will not be displayed on Tasmanian Team uniforms and/or Tasmanian Practice shirts without the prior approval of the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc. – Adult Tournament Sub-Committee.

Bowlers must follow the directives given by the Team managers and Coaches at all times. The aims and objectives of the team as a whole will not be jeopardized through the acts of individual team members.

Team members and/or his/her family shall not at any time post on any public forum any comments which in the absolute discretion of the TBT Board may be regarded as critical of TBT, TBT Committees, Team Management, Team Coaches, Team Members or other bowlers in general.

Failure by any team member to adhere to the Declaration and TBT Code of Conduct Agreement may result in them being replaced in the team by the next available reserve or removal and departure from the team at their own expenses.
